

### **What is Lanarkshire Cancer Care Trust ?**

- ✦ Lanarkshire Cancer Care Trust is an independent charity who provide volunteer drivers to take cancer patients to hospital appointments, clinics and daycare facilities

### **Who can use the driver service?**

- ✦ Any cancer patient living within the boundaries of NHS Lanarkshire can ask for help. The service is primarily for people who have no other means of getting to their appointments and who could not cope with hospital transport.

### **How is Lanarkshire Cancer Care Trust funded?**

- ✦ Approximately 85% of our funding is raised by the patients and the general public in the form of donations and special fundraising events. The remainder of the funding comes from annual grants. These grants are from NHS Lanarkshire and North and South Lanarkshire Councils.

### **What is the money spent on?**

- ✦ Our volunteer drivers from all over North and South Lanarkshire give their time and vehicles free of charge. We repay them for their fuel costs and their phone calls.

### **Who runs the Trust?**

- ✦ A board of Trustees, who are volunteers, oversee the business affairs of the Trust.
- ✦ The Trust needs around £4000 per week to repay drivers fuel costs. We organise various fund raising events throughout the year and we would appreciate any support you can give to these events.
